Collection Days Monday through Friday beginning at 7:00 a.m.

The City of Sugar Hill offers three (3) separate options for residential garbage service:

“Pay as You Throw” Special Bag System -

1. “Special Bags” and their contents are to be placed curbside (within five (5) feet of the curb) on the scheduled day of collection. New lower prices effective November 1, 2009, each box of 20 bags is \$25.00 per box.
2. May be purchased at Ace Hardware 4300 Buford Dr., Kroger 1605 Buford Hwy., Kroger 400 Peachtree Ind. Blvd., Publix 5885 Cumming Hwy., Quality Foods 4450 Nelson Brogdon Blvd., Publix 1000 Peachtree Ind. Blvd.

Cart System –

Special bags are only required when contents will not fit inside the cart. New, lower cart prices listed below are effective as of November 1, 2009.

1. 95-gallon cart collection, including the cost of recycling: \$34.50 (billed quarterly)
2. 65-gallon cart collection, including the cost of recycling: \$30.00 (billed quarterly)

CURBSIDE RECYCLING is FREE!

Newly expanded curbside recycling now includes 33 recyclable items.

THINGS TO KEEP OUT OF RECYCLING BINS:

• Aerosol Cans • Antifreeze Bottles • Bleach Bottles • Facial Tissue • Food Paper Wrap • Motor Oil Cans • Paint Cans • Paper Towels • Plastic Wrap • Styrofoam • Window Panes • Tissue Paper

THE “SPECIAL BAG” HAS ADDITIONAL USES!

“Bulky Waste” such as discarded furniture, hot water heaters, washer and dryers, or packaging boxes too large to fit into a “Special Bag” or approved cart(s) and weighing less than 50 lbs, residents may place the item alongside regular garbage and recycling bins at the curb or roadside. To ensure collection of the bulky item, attach one (1) “Special Bag” to each bulky item so that the bag will be clearly visible to the collection crew.

Hazardous Material(s)

Freon bearing appliances such as *refrigerators, freezers and air conditioning units* CANNOT be collected by Advanced Disposal unless, the hazardous materials have been properly removed by a certified technician and properly marked with the red, certified state tag. **The resident is responsible for all costs associated with the removal of the hazardous material.**

Residents can call any company that specializes in the removal of hazardous materials, such as:

Examples of **BULKY ITEMS** or materials which will not be picked up by Advanced Disposal are:

• Construction Material • Remodeling Debris • Large Auto Parts • Small Engines Containing Gas or Oils • Propane or Butane Tanks • Containers Containing Paints • Any Other Chemicals

Holiday Schedule -

Advanced Disposal observes three (3) major holidays during the year; New Year’s Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day.

As a rule, if your pick up day falls on one of these holidays, garbage and recycling service will run one day late for the balance of the week. Trucks may arrive earlier during holidays so place your trash out the night before.
