

## City Manager Report for February 2009

- **City Hall:**

  2. \* Cemetery Fence (weather permitting) will be finished this month.

- **Streets:**
  1. The 2009 Road Resurfacing Project includes the following streets:
  2. Railroad Ave and Old Suwanee Road will be resurfaced in the next four (4) months. The City has contracted to have curb/gutters installed as part of that project. The sidewalk will be added later this year when the heavy equipment work is completed.

  2. \* Gary Pirkle Park vehicle and pedestrian bridge contract has been finalized.
  3. \* Gary Pirkle Park synthetic athletic field's contract has been finalized and equipment is being mobilized to the park.
  4. \* Precision Planning was selected to design contract for the 18 acres to expansion of EE Robinson Park. This design will use bio-filtration techniques for stormwater collection and will have paths, approximately 200 parking spots, a playground and a 400 foot baseball/softball ball field.

  2. The clubhouse received water damage last week. A RFP for design and expansion of the building will be advertised this month.
