- **City Hall:**

 5. **Sugar Hill Annual Spring Clean Up days are scheduled for This Wednesday, May 14th north of Hwy 20 and next Wednesday, May 21st south of Hwy 20**. Flyers went out in the April Gas bills, emails were sent to HOA contacts and posted on the website.

 1. **RR Ave and Hillcrest Ave** will be under construction for approximately one year for natural gas, water and reuse line installation.
 2. **The water lines in Hickory Hills Trailer Park have been replaced. Construction will begin the end of May.**
