

City Manager Report for August 2008

- **City Hall:**
 1. **City website: Construction Watch icon**, location and status of City construction sites.
 2. Receive your Newsletter and Construction Watch updates via email. Click on the "Email List" link on the City website.
 3. Council Meeting Agenda **E-Packets** are posted on the City website www.cityofsugarhill.com
 4. Proposals for the cemetery fencing on Church St. and W. Broad St. are in the review process and they will be a brick and wrought iron combination fence.
- **Streets:**
 1. **RR Ave, Old Suwanee Road and Hillcrest Ave** will be under construction for approximately one year for natural gas, water and reuse line installation.
 2. **Hickory Hills Trailer Park sidewalk project is complete**.
 3. Curbing has been installed on Hillcrest Dr in the area of the reuse line installation. This curbing is the first phase of installing sidewalks on Hillcrest after the reuse line construction is complete.
 4. A new storm drain culvert and some curbing has been installed on Frontier Drive to repair an older failed structure.
 5. Proposals for landscaping portions of the Peachtree Industrial Blvd and Hwy 20 have been reviewed and Bayou Scapes has been selected to perform this landscaping project. The project should begin within two weeks.
 6. The City continues to work with GDOT to keep the Hwy 20 expansion on schedule. A list of government contacts will be on the website for the public to contact their State and Federal elected officials.
