

City Manager Report for September 2008

- **City Hall:**
 1. **City website: Construction Watch icon**, location and status of City construction sites.

 1. **RR Ave, Old Suwanee Road and Hillcrest Ave** will be under construction for approximately one year for natural gas, water and reuse line installation.
 2. Curbing has been installed on Hillcrest Dr and sidewalks are being installed.
 3. Landscaping a portion of the Peachtree Industrial Blvd and Hwy 20 is complete. We are researching extending this project to Wages Way on Hwy 20.
 4. The City continues to work with GDOT to keep the Hwy 20 expansion on schedule. A list of government contacts will be on the website for the public to contact their State and Federal elected officials.

 4. The new parking lot on Level Creek is progressing well; the detention pond is functioning as designed, the first layer of asphalt has been installed. New lights for the parking lot and upper parking lot at EE Robinson have been ordered. Landscaping of the parking lot will be complete prior to the Fall Festival.
 5. Gary Pirkle Park Pre-Construction Notification has been submitted to the Corps of Engineers. Grading of the site will resume when the Corps approves our plan.
