

## City Manager's End of Year Report for 2006

- **City Hall:**
  1. The **Sugar Hill Contract Postal Unit (CPU)** produced over **\$153,900** in sales.
  2. Employees and citizens of Sugar Hill collected over 100 toys and hundreds of canned goods for the North Gwinnett Co-Op and Toys for Tots.
  3. Approved engineering plans for West Broad St., Pond & Company, design engineer.
  4. Construction (first of four) city entrance monuments on PIB.
  5. Remodeled City Hall Annex.
- **Roads:**
  1. The City patched and resurfaced **4 miles** of streets.
  2. Installed **one (1) mile** of sidewalks.
  3. Planted Crape Myrtles and shrubs to enhance Peachtree Industrial Blvd. We are coordinating with Georgia DOT to plant on Hwy 20 after the improvement project.
  4. Improved the Maintenance Complex office area, parking, equipment, material storage areas in addition to landscaping the entrance on Hillcrest Ave.
  5. Collected and processed over **972 tons** of landscape materials from citizens.
  6. Pinecrest Road; installed curb, gutter, storm drains, sidewalks and resurfaced.
  7. Hickory Hills Dr., April Dr. Hickory Hills Circle; installed curb, gutter, sidewalks and resurfaced.
- **Planning and Zoning:**
  1. **Kaipo Awana** was promoted to the Director of Planning and Development.
  2. **Tim Schick** hired as the City Planner.
  3. **5 annexations** were approved for a total City growth of **62 acres**.
  4. **13 rezoning** applications were processed.
  5. **23 construction / development permits** were issued.
  6. **2604 building inspections** were performed.
  7. **249 Certificates of Occupancy** were issued.
  8. Awarded Livable Cities Initiative (LCI) Grandfather Status for the W. Broad Street Town Center Master Plan.
- **Recreation:**
  1. **Andy McQuagge** hired as the Director of Recreation.
  2. **Constructing two (2) new concession/restroom** buildings in EE Robinson Park.
  3. Reels at Robinson had **five (5) free movies** in the amphitheater.
  4. **July 3<sup>rd</sup> music and fireworks** celebration.
  5. **First Annual Easter Egg Hunt**.
  6. **Sixth Annual Fall Festival** with a parade, 5K race, musical concerts, car show and first annual chili cook off.
  7. **Annual Town Green Holiday Celebration** held on December 2<sup>nd</sup> was a great success.
  8. **Recreational Program a great success**, held summer and fall classes for children and adults.
  9. Initiated development plans for **49 acre park on Austin Garner Rd.** Precision Planning, design engineer.
- **Golf:**
  1. **Renovated all 18 greens** with dwarf Bermuda grass.
  2. **Rebuilt 32 sand bunkers**.
  3. **Renovated** the clubhouse with news tables and chairs, couches and wall mounted flat screen TV.
  4. **Improved drainage** of fairways.
- **Gas:**
  1. **427 new customers** were added to our system.
  2. Installed over **5.2 miles** of new service lines.
  3. Installed over **8.4 miles** of 2" & 4" main gas supply lines.
