

## City Manager Report for August 2007

- **City Hall:**
  1. Very proud of Sugar Hill for being one of the first City's in Georgia to actively spray and spread Larvicide against mosquitoes. Five cases have been confirmed in South Gwinnett.
  2. West Broad Street Improvements Program is in final design. September Public Meeting will be held in the Community Center to discuss the plan and Right of Way needed for the improvements.
  3. Don Kelemen has been hired as the City Community Relations Director.
- **Streets:**
  1. **City Streets for 2007 Resurfacing Program: Azalea Crest Lane (complete), Blue Cedar Dr. (complete), Blue Cedar Walk (complete), Chapel Ave., Highland Ave., Pine Street (complete), Pinetree Circle (patched - LARP), Saddletree Ct. (complete), Saddletree Way (complete), Second Ave (patched - LARP), Sylvan St. (curb-gutter and patched - LARP), White Cedar Terrace (complete), Whitehead Road (W. Broad to Sunset is complete), Wild Timber Road (complete).** Completed improvements are in **BOLD**. This list is posted on the website.
  2. **Extension of the sidewalk on Whitehead Road begins in late August.**
  3. **Whitehead Road and Arbor View Lane will become a three-way stop and speed limit reduced to 35mph.**
- **Stormwater:**
  1. Integrated Science & Engineering (ISE) has been awarded the **2007 Stormwater Program**, bid through a cooperative effort of cities in the Gwinnett Municipal Association.
  2. **Sugar Hill is the first City to file their Stormwater Audit with GA EPD.**

  4. Sugar Hill has a complaint/report of violations system online **CARES**; it is located on the Home Page for the convenience of our citizens.
- **Recreation:**
  1. **Adult softball returns to Sugar Hill September 4<sup>th</sup>.**
  2. Final coordination and scheduling for the **October 20<sup>th</sup> Fall Festival.**
- **Golf:**
  1. **The Golf Course is in the best condition ever.** Capital Improvements over the last four years have significantly improved the course and its amenities.
  2. Resident and Gas Customer Cards are available for purchase to receive rates \$10 lower than normal. Come and enjoy great golf and beautiful scenery.
- **Gas:**
  1. Received the **APGA Safety Award for the 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive year.**
  2. **52** new services in July, **171** YTD.
  3. Installed **1,500** ft of new service lines in May.
