

City Manager's Report for July 2005

- **Roads:**
 1. The 2005 Road Improvement Program has begun. These improvements are phased: (1) grinding and patching, (2) resurfacing and (3) manhole replacement by Gwinnett DOT.
 2. A new storm drainage system is being installed on Level Creek. After installation, the sidewalk will be extended to Oak Grove for connectivity.
- **Planning and Zoning:**
 1. **63** construction permits were issued during June.
 2. **133** building /erosion inspections were performed in June.
 3. **11** Erosion Control Inspections were performed.
 4. The Sugar Hill Land Use Plan has been sent to the Georgia DCA.
 5. The Town Center Master Plan is in coordination with the Atlanta Regional Commission.
- **Recreation:**
 1. Precision Planning is designing **new restroom facilities and concession stand** at EE Robinson Park. Construction should be complete this year.
 2. Next **Reels at Robinson** movie will be **August 19th** and showing **Shark Tale**.
 3. **"Rockets over Robinson" was a great success!!!!**
 4. Pre-Bid Conference was held for design of a **49 acre park on Austin Garner Road**. Timeline to select an Engineering firm to design is September. This park will have both passive and active recreation areas.
 5. **New "Tot-Lot"** playground equipment should be installed by August.
