



City Manager's Report for September 2005

- **City Hall:**
 1. The Mayor and Council in coordination with the American Red Cross will be having a **Hurricane Katrina Victim's Relief Fund Golf Tournament** on **Monday, September 26th** at the Sugar Hill Golf Club. Information and flyers are available on the City website.
- **Roads:**
 1. The 2005 Road Improvement Program has begun. These improvements are phased: (1) grinding and patching, (2) resurfacing and (3) manhole replacement by Gwinnett DOT.
 2. **Over 6,500** ft of City streets have been **resurfaced**.
 3. **Over 5,500** feet have been **patched** and will be resurfaced in the near future.
 4. **Over 1,500** feet are still to be patched and resurfaced this year.
- **Planning and Zoning:**
 1. **62** construction permits were issued during August.
 2. **207** building / erosion inspections were performed in August.
 3. **16** Erosion Control Inspections were performed.
 4. The Town Center Master Plan is in final review before submission to the Atlanta Regional Commission.
- **Recreation:**
 1. The final **Reels at Robinson** movie will be **September 16th** and showing **Sinbad**.
 2. Precision Planning is designing **new restroom facilities and concession stand** at EE Robinson Park. Construction will begin after the Fall Festival and should be complete this year.
 3. Precision Planning has been awarded the contract to design Phase one (feasibility and layout) of a **49 acre park on Austin Garner Road**. This park will have both passive and active recreation areas.
- **Golf:**
 1. The condition of the golf course continues to improve. We had over 2,000 rounds of golf played in August.
 2. The Sugar Hill Golf Association Championship will be played this month on Saturday the 24th and Sunday the 25th.

 1. **27** new services in August.
