While other governments are raising taxes and cutting services, Sugar Hill will continue to provide the highest quality services to our citizens. Food, inflatable rides, bands, best fireworks in Gwinnett County and movie “Night at the Museum II” are planned.
 3. **Gary Pirkle Park Community Garden BARN is complete.** Irrigation system is in place.
 4. **Gary Pirkle Park Parking Expansion** is going well: Suwanee Dam Road Entrance, flagstone column / wrought iron fence is complete and gate braces have been installed. 140 additional parking spots with bio-filtration stormwater controls.
 5. **18 acre EE Robinson Park expansion contract awarded to Reeves Contracting of Sugar Hill is going well.** This Phase I expansion will also use bio-filtration techniques for stormwater collection and will have approximately 200 additional parking spots and an event entrance on Peachtree Industrial Blvd.
 6. **EE Robinson Park Ball fields:** 1) work has begun to clear the area for the T-Ball fields on Level Creek road. 2) old soccer field being converted to two (2) Little League fields with grass infields; concrete walkways, pads for bleachers, lights and fencing are being installed.
 7. **On June 10th & 11th, NGHS in cooperation with Sugar Hill hosted a regional qualification 7 vs. 7 Tournament at GPP.** NGHS qualified for the national tournament in Hoover, AL.
