



Georgia Energy Code Changes

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 1, 2011

ENFORCEMENT DATE: April 1, 2011
(Blower tests: July 1, 2011)

January 1st 2011, the State of Georgia adopted the International Energy Conservation Code, 2009 Edition, published by the International Code Council. In addition, Georgia State Supplements and Amendments were adopted and shall constitute the official Georgia State Minimum Standard Energy Code.

As of April 1st 2011, it is mandatory that all residential and commercial permit applications submitted to the City of Sugar Hill contain calculations indicating that the construction meets compliance with these regulations. Acceptable calculations shall be REScheck or COMcheck compliance pathways. These programs may be obtained free of charge from the D.O.E. online at www.energycodes.gov. When following these guidelines, use the Georgia Version.
